٥	Personal Undertaking	"I WILL consistently prioritize safety and the protection of the environment in ALL my work activities."
•••	Driver Safety	Associates MUST drive safely, in accordance with local driving laws and Gilbarco Veeder-Root driving policies. This includes prohibition of texting while driving, the mandatory use of seat belts where fitted and compliance with speed restrictions.
٨	Work Control Procedures	Associates MUST only undertake activities where they have the correct authority and competence. Associates must always follow the issued work control procedures or stop and speak up when they are either unsure or believe the procedures to be inadequate.
þ	Energy Isolation (Lock Out and Tag Out)	Associates MUST always ensure all energy sources are locked out to prevent inadvertent release, which might cause harm and communicate all isolations to relevant others. This includes electrical, mechanical, hydraulic, pneumatic, and kinetic energies.
	Barricading and Guarding	Associates MUST always protect themselves from impact and entanglement. This includes effective defensive parking as well as the correct use of machine guards and barriers.
	Confined Space Entry	Associates MUST avoid entering confined spaces where possible. Entry must only be undertaken with correct authority, competence, equipment including continuous atmosphere testing and an effective rescue plan in place.
	Working at Height	Associates MUST avoid working at height where possible. Work at height must only be undertaken with correct authority, competence, and approved fall protection with an effective emergency rescue plan in place.
	Suspended Loads	Associates MUST NOT walk or work under suspended loads or work in the line of fire of plant or equipment. This includes suspended tanks and dispensers.
R	Drugs and Alcohol	Associates MUST NOT attempt to work when under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Any associate working whilst taking prescription drugs MUST advise their line manager if there is a potential to impact on workplace safety.
	Personal Safety Equipment	Associates MUST wear all personal protective safety equipment as instructed in the work control procedures and in accordance with requirements resulting from the local risk assessment.
